## FROM THE CHAPTER DIRECTOR'S CHAIR

As Annabelle and I enter our second year as your Chapter Directors these thoughts I have had on the volunteer force that makes our Chapter run has finally been put to words.

Volunteers are the lifeblood of the nonprofit sector. Just about every not-for-profit organization uses volunteers in some capacity. In most cases, board members serve without compensation. For many of these organizations, volunteers do all the work, from planting the trees to paying the bills. Even if your organization employs paid staff, volunteers still provide valuable service. Organizations like ours depend on volunteers to take care of everything. The volunteer staff takes care of the books, produces and prints newsletters, organizes fun activities, keeps an inventory of goods for the members and generally cares about the well-being of everyone involved, whether they be part of the staff or just a member. Many times they are likely to be balancing careers with raising families, not to mention taking care of aging parents, going to the gym, going to school, and keeping up with e-mail.

Understanding why people volunteer makes it easier to find volunteers, organize

their work and talents, and recognize their contributions. Not everyone is motivated by the same factors. People volunteer for a variety of reasons, including their desire to:

**Help the community and others.** Helping others usually comes to mind first when people think of volunteers. But as you see when you read deeper in this list, their motives aren't always this simple.

**Increase self-esteem.** Volunteering makes people feel better about themselves. Giving a few hours a week, or even a month, to an organization creates good feelings.

**Help out friends.** Friends are often the first people we turn to when we need help. Volunteering also can create a great way to get together with friends on a regular basis.

**Make new friends.** Volunteering is usually a social activity. People use this opportunity to meet interesting people who share their interests and values.

**Develop new skills.** A volunteer job often gives people an opportunity to learn how to do something they didn't know how to do.

**Enjoy something they love.** Many volunteer jobs come with intrinsic benefits for their participants. In our case, a love of motorcycles and riding has brought us together.

With all of this in mind, we begin our second year as your volunteer Chapter Directors and are looking forward to another fun year, hoping that more of you out there feel the urge to step up and join us. This Chapter is as strong as its members and I firmly believe we have some of the best in the West!

## RIDER EDUCATION

### "R"ider Education Notes

#### *Standing in for "R" Chapter Educator*

Car tires on motorcycles in my opinion is not safe! I am going to include a link to YouTube showing this being done and if you watch closely you will see that when the motorcycle leans into a turn, the tire comes up on the edge of the tread which makes a very small contact patch with the

pavement. If it is raining you are probably going to go down which is not a good thing! Motorcycle tire manufacturer's spend millions of dollars designing tires for our machines, so don't try to save money by putting a car tire on your bike.

Here are a few of the differences in the two types of tires. Motorcycle tires have thread that wraps around onto the sidewall to give you nearly the same contact patch when the bike leans over into a turn that you have when you are riding straight down the road. The sidewalls are made stiffer to help with this. A car tire has

flat tread because a car does not lean over when it turns and the sidewalls have a lot of flex (I went out to our car and pushed the sidewall with my thumb and could move them with 30psi of air pressure in them) which means that the sidewalls are made of thinner rubber and do not have tread on them so if the road is wet when you lean the bike over in a turn you have lost all possibility of having any control of your motorcycle.

You have probably heard a story of someone who rode a couple of hundred miles on a "RUNFLAT CAR TIRE" and my thoughts on this are that if

they had done a proper "T-CLOC" inspection, they would not have had this problem to begin with. The problem, most likely, was not with the tire but with the valve stem. I have had metal valve stems on my bike for over a year now and have not had a problem with them. Look into them for your safety. Again, in my humble opinion, don't run car tires or run flat tires on your bike!
