One day, I decided it was time to move up and I sold my first love and bought a new 1972 Honda 750 Four. Oh my!! What speed and power I had now. This was a motorcycle!! After a couple of years **it wasn't as fast as some of**

the other bikes, so I entered the world of aftermarket improvements. A Yoshimura engine kit and a clutch and we had speed again. That bike gave way to the one I put up on Facebook. 1982 Honda 1100 CBX. 6 cylinders, 24 valves, 6 pipes and power to spare. It had bags and I bought it because I wanted to be able to pack stuff and do a little touring. It was a great bike, but not a touring bike, so that sent me to the dealer one more time in 1983 for that black Goldwing Interstate. This was luxury for sure. I spent more money on chrome and lights than the bike cost new to begin with, but the mighty Gold Wing had set the hook and I was in her spell. That led to a 1986 Aspencade which became a 1990 1500 SE and now I ride a 2008 GL1800. There were a few years between those bikes, but the bug never went away. It has been a fun ride **and I wouldn't trade one moment away. I don't know if** the 1800 will be the last Wing or not. Time will tell, but if

Mr. Honda makes it a 2000 or adds a couple cylinders, I may not be able to stop myself. The Gold Wing hook is **strong and can't be broken.**

**So what's your story? How did you get to the Gold Wing stage of your life?** However it was, I bet you have memories of great bikes and great rides and some very special friends. I know I do.

# RIDER EDUCATION

## The Friction Zone

The friction zone is that part of the clutch lever travel from where the clutch just starts to engage until it is fully engaged. In the picture it is the range

between 3 and 4. If you constantly stall or have awkward/erratic (jumpy) starts when you operate the clutch lever then the problem is that you are releasing the clutch lever too quickly - more to the point, you are failing to hesitate while in the friction zone (between 3 and 4 in the diagram) as the engine speed and rear wheel speed synchronize before easing that lever all the way out.



Phrases like "release the clutch lever" or "ease out the clutch" do NOT mean that you are to release that clutch lever all the way out! I know, somebody should have told you that when you were learning to ride, but they didn't.

Those phrases really meant that you were to ease out the clutch lever UNTIL you reach the friction zone and then you are to HESITATE there until the engine and the rear wheel speeds synchronize. THEN, you ease the clutch lever all the way out.

If you are starting from a dead stop this is particularly important as the rear wheel is turning at zero rpm while the engine is turning at more than 1,000 rpm.

Nothing that you can do with

the clutch lever while it is outside of the 3-4 range makes any difference whatever to the motorcycle. You can move it quickly or slowly, in small or large increments, and the clutch lever outside of the range of 3-4 does nothing.

So it makes sense for you to become INTIMATELY familiar with that zone. As the clutch lever can save your life, can get you OUT of most control problems with your motorcycle, you MUST MASTER its usage before you begin testing your skills with any other motorcycle control.

Stay cool and ride safe.

We tried to take in as much as we could in our five **days and attended the 'Welcome Party'** at the Knoxville Zoo; opening ceremonies; the Talent Show; BBQ dinner; the entertainment show; one of the **riverboat breakfasts; the Masters' breakfast;** and the closing ceremonies. In **between, we also made rides to Deal's Gap and the Cherohala Skyway** (both are great); worked security at the Trade Show; attended and bought lots of goodies at the Trade Show; met many new friends; enjoyed meeting old friends; and just had a wonderful week, in spite of the heat and humidity.

The facilities were great - Knoxville Convention Center. Unfortunately, parking was a problem and there were a few first day glitches with shuttle buses; but that got fixed. Riding events

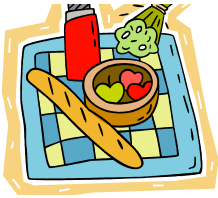

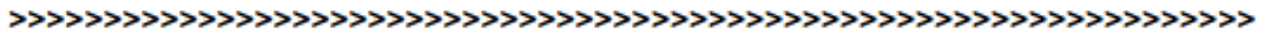
