This month I want to talk a little about "SAFETY CHROME." Yes, we all chuckle and make little jokes about needing that shiny new chrome piece with the beautiful LED lights in it and justify its purchase by calling it the aforementioned "SAFETY CHROME." Truth is, the tag is very close to the truth and every little light and shiny chrome piece does increase our visibility in traffic or out on the open road. They look real nice, too!



To demonstrate my point, a couple of weeks ago I was invited on a short ride by a friend and former co-worker. He and his buddy that went with us were on a couple of sport bikes. By all the tests and stories about these bikes, they are wicked fast and a Goldwing would be outmatched on the street. Anyway, it was just before 8:30 pm when we took off so it was completely dark. The ride went well, the Goldwing proved it was a worthy companion on the curves because of the incredible headlights they have. The sport bikes didn't light the whole turn even with high beams on. Ok, so now to the safety chrome part. We rode down I 17 and the sport bikes' small tail lights blended in with the rest of the traffic to the point which you could not tell if you were following a motorcycle or not. In heavy traffic it was easy to lose sight of the other bikes and not "see" them until you were right up on them. As a matter of fact, I was almost right beside the dark blue R1 before I could accurately separate it from the car he was tucked in behind. This is not good.

The comment I got from both riders when we got back was that when they were behind me there was no doubt where I was and more important, what I was. All the added extra safety chrome and lights made my bike stand out in a crowd while they just blended in.

This little un-scientific test proved to me that when cage drivers say they didn't see the bike coming, it might be partly true. Sure they are distracted a lot of the time, but the added visual that a well-lit motorcycle gives may help to overcome some of that distraction and help us be seen better. No, I am not selling chrome for Goldwings but next time I use the term "SAFETY CHROME" it will have a new meaning for me.

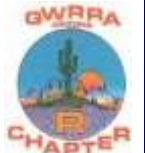
Well, that's all for this month. Keep them shiny and the rubber side down. Thanks for riding along.

Many rumors are circulating on chest compressions with no breaths. We can still use breaths. Compressions have changed a little but it is the way the new procedures are to be done that is the major change. CPR is still the same with a few changes that will improve the chance of survival.

We will be training using our normal programs until the new programs come out in April. All Instructors have the new updates and will use them where they are needed in their training of our Members. Each Instructor will explain the new changes as they go through the class. They will make sure everyone understands the new changes and why they are being used for a better chance of survival.

We had an outstanding 2010, teaching over 1,600 members. We sent out nine life-saving awards in 2010 and look forward to sending out more in 2011.

The Membership of GWRRRA is the best anyone can ask for in an outstanding organization. The Members came forward when someone needed help and stayed there until help arrived and went above and beyond to help.

AZR RIDE REWARDS—2011

The Ride Rewards program has changed for 2011. Originally, the program was created to promote riding your bike to GWRRA events. Now, instead of being awarded MILEAGE to an event, participants will be awarded POINTS for attending, regardless what mode of transportation is used. Ride your motorcycle, drive your car, or walk—it will make no difference. Points for attending will be awarded as follows:

AZ-R Chapter breakfast gathering	75
Any AZ-R Event*	150
Any AZ-R Function**	25
Any other AZ-R meeting***	50
Any other GWRRA Chapter gathering****	25
AZ District Rally	150
Any other Region F District Rally*****	100
Region F Rally	250
Any other GWRRA Region Rally	150
Wing Ding	500

**AZ-R Function: AZ-R Rides, Dinners, etc.

AZ-R HIGH MILEAGE AWARD FOR 2011

This is strictly a mileage award for registered GWRRA members. The contest will run for the 2011 calendar year, beginning 1/1/2011. Members need to submit a time/date stamped digital photo of their odometer on or after January 1st. Your GWRRA membership card must show in the photo for ID purposes along with your mileage. There is no restriction on how you get the miles—rides after chapter meetings, commuting, and riding to Wing Ding are examples. Send the photos to me at rca43@live.com. If you have the luxury of owning two motorcycles, both bikes are eligible. Photos of both odometers will be required. Purchase of a new bike will require open and closing photos of both bikes.

To be eligible for the Ride Rewards and High Mileage Award programs, participants must also attend a minimum of 6 AZ-R Chapter Breakfast Gatherings during the 2011 calendar year.

AWARDS

The Top Participation Points winner - \$100.

Second place - \$50.

The remaining participants' names will be put in a hat and the winning draw will receive \$25.

The High Mileage winner - \$100.

AZR RIDE REWARDS

For each GWRRA meeting, ride, or event you attend, you receive points for attendance. In January, 2012 we will draw from the list for cash prizes. To qualify for the drawing, you need to be a registered GWRRA member, have a minimum of 1,000 points, and have attended at least 6 Chapter R meetings.
