## FROM THE CHAPTER DIRECTOR'S CHAIR

Steve & Annabelle Penrose - Chapter Directors

When riding a motorcycle it is vital to stay safe. Protective clothing is important to prevent injury in the event of an accident. The right helmet is especially important, as this is what will protect your head in the event of an impact. All too often we see riders that think they are being safe by wearing those cheap plastic "hats." They may as well wear nothing at all.

Helmets can be purchased online, but it is advisable to try them on in a store before you buy one. There are a number of different models in various styles, sizes, and colors. Often a rider chooses one to match their clothing or their motorcycle.

Safety is the most important factor in helmets when considering making a purchase. In order for it to be safe, it has to fit. If it is too tight, then it will become uncomfortable and it could make it harder for you to turn your head. It is worse if it is too loose as this will not be as effective in cushioning the impact and in the worst case

scenario will fall off.

The best way to do this is to try different helmets in a store. You need to be able to look up and down as well as side to side. The helmet should be worn for at least five minutes in order to gauge how comfortable it is. If you feel pressure anywhere on your head then you should try another one. Helmets are sold as small, medium, and large, but every manufacturer will be slightly different so try many before you purchase one.

The next thing to consider is the style of helmet. Full-face, open-face and half-helmet are options. Try them all to see which feels the best for you. **Some riders don't like** a full-face because they feel claustrophobic. If that is the case, there are new convertible types that may feel better. Check to see if the visor is anti-fog and anti-scratch to give you clear vision at all times.

Helmets should be comfortable and stylish, but most



importantly of all, safe. They should either be DOT approved for impact absorption or Snell approved for roll off capability, dynamic strength and penetration. Check customer reviews if available to see what other riders say about them.

As we, here in Arizona, enter our hot riding season, it is important to note that a proper fitting helmet can regulate the temperature inside and may help you stay more alert while riding.

Lets all stay safe and enjoy the ride.

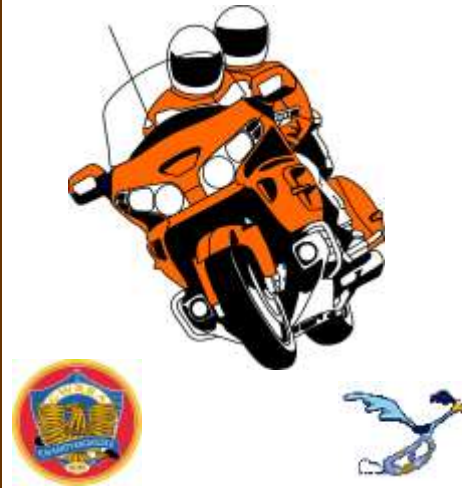

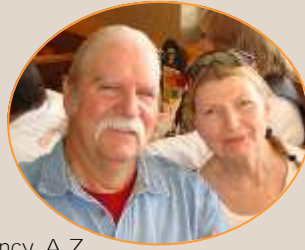
